Penn Warehousing and Distribution does the warehousing operations at Piers 38-40, 74, and 78-80. These piers form the Port’s Forest Products Distribution Center. This facility recently attracted Finland’s M-real paper company, which will send 150,000 tons of high-grade paper per year to the Port of Philadelphia on the ships of Wagenborg steamship line.

JH Stevedoring does the stevedoring operations at the same piers.

Horizon Stevedoring, which operates the Port’s Pier 82, specializes in the transportation and storage of perishable goods. Their main customer is Turbana Bananas, which sends a ship a week from Columbia to South Philadelphia.

Penn Warehousing and Distribution's new Web sites offer customers access to the latest industry, company and Port information as it becomes available.
